

Ironwood Mailbox Restrictions

This document is designed to offer clarity around our mailbox restrictions. The HOA Declaration of *Restrictions* states:

Article 1,16: Use of Land

All residents shall have a painted cedar mailbox, color to match the Structure's siding color, as approved under Article II hereof and the United States Postal Service, the size, color, design, numbering, brackets and location are subject to approval by the Architectural Control Committee should an issue arise that requires intervention. A recommended design is shown in Exhibit A.

This means your mailbox must be wood, painted to match your house, and should resemble the example. We allow matching your home's siding color or white without question. If you want a different color, ask before painting. Your house number should be on each side of your mailbox. A newspaper box is optional. Shingles are recommended for looks and longevity but not required.
